Following record turnouts at the polls for the general election in November and renewed interest in the fundamental right to vote, the League of Women Voters of the Hamptons has invited the Suffolk County Board of Elections to discuss “The Workings of the Board of Elections” at its next meeting on Monday, January 12, at 7 p.m.

Open to the public, the free program featuring speaker Thomas Knobel of East Hampton, Assistant to Board of Elections Commissioner Cathy Richter Geier, takes place at the Unitarian Universalist Meetinghouse, located across from Ziggy’s Restaurant, at 977 Bridgehampton-Sag Harbor Turnpike in Bridgehampton.

Issues to be addressed will include absentee ballots, the voter registration purging process, election day challenges, ballot recounts, training of poll workers, and the status of voting machine selection for Suffolk County.
