'TOWN GOVERNMENT: A MODEL FOR TODAY AND TOMORROW'

To learn what professional managers offer today's towns, the League of Women Voters of the Hamptons is hosting a free public forum titled "Town Government: A Model for Today and Tomorrow" on Monday, July 13, at 7 p.m.

The local government think-a-thon, which all members of the public are invited to attend, will take place at the Unitarian Universalist Meetinghouse, 977 Bridgehampton-Sag Harbor Turnpike in Bridgehampton, two miles north of Montauk Highway, across from Ziggy's Restaurant.

Three panelists will explain the role of professional town managers/administrators and their relationship to the town supervisor and board. They include Alfred A. Gatta, vice-president of the New York State City-County Managers Association, who also serves as the Village Manager of Scarsdale; Steve Altieri, Administrator of the Town of Mamaroneck; and local East Hampton Village Administrator Larry Cantwell.

Moderating will be Sandra Ferguson of Bridgehampton, a former president of the League.

Refreshments will precede the program, and a question-and-answer session will follow.
